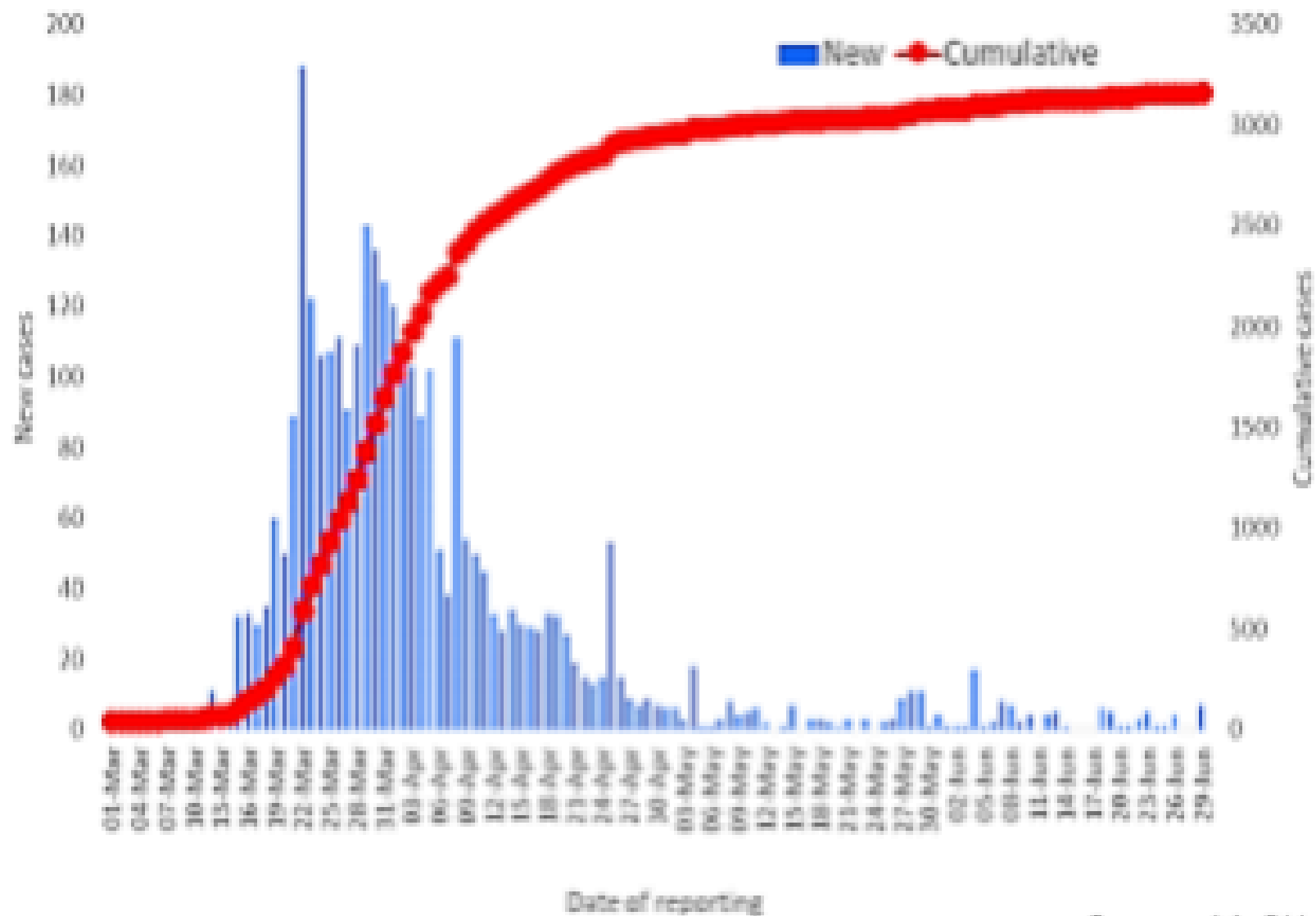

Public Health Measures



- Active Surveillance, Screening, Tracing
 - ✓ Quarantine (Arrival and Dept. passengers screening)
 - ✓ Hospital Screening
- Health facilities & Medical Equipment and Supplies
 - ✓ ICU, non –ICU bed, Negative pressure unit, N95 face masks, sets of PPE and ventilators are available. Includes Sufficient stocks of drugs, Field hospital, Hospitel etc
- Primary Health Care
 - ✓ Particularly in well-trained and committed health care workers as well as surveillance systems, has proved invaluable



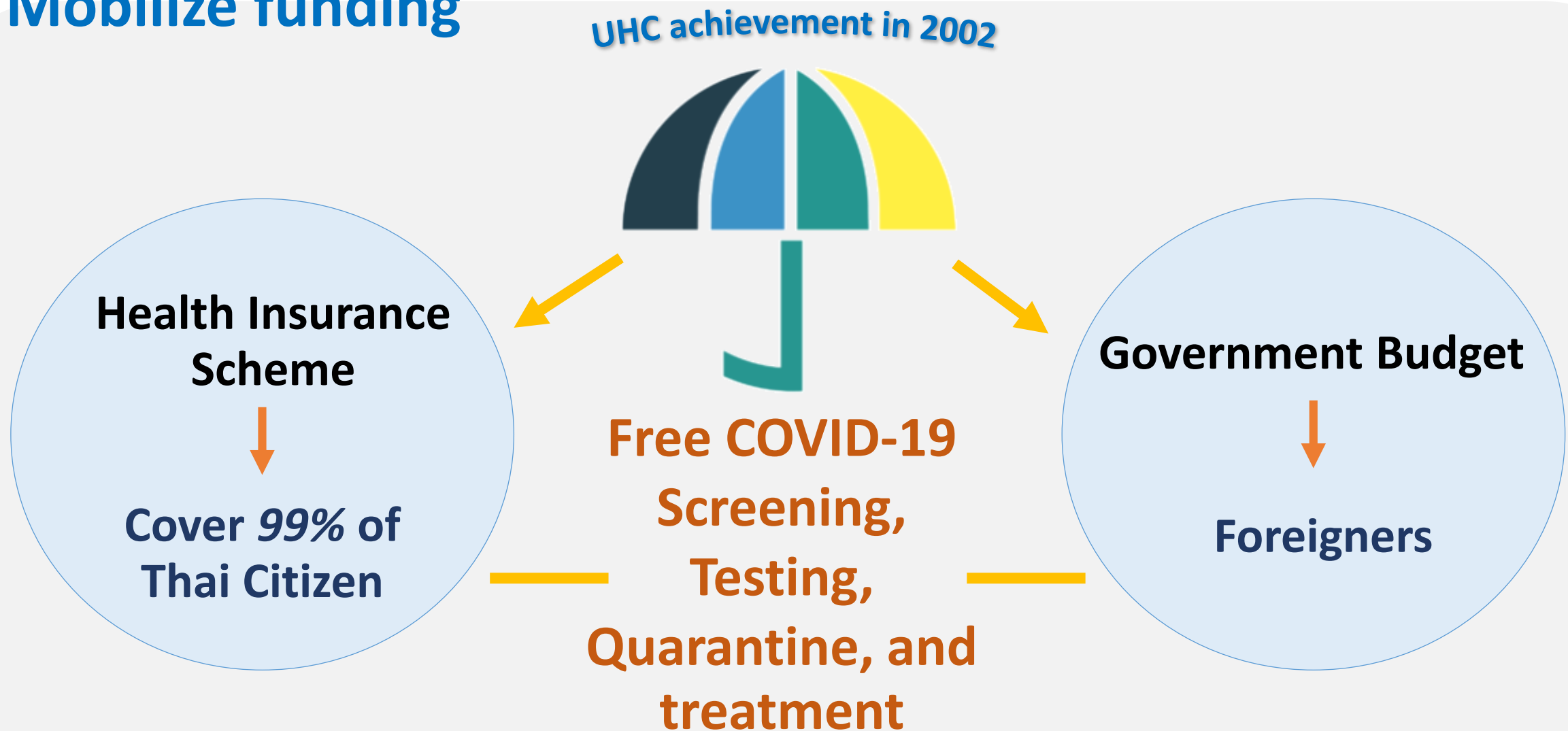
Effective Social Measures



- Established the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration
- Public Communication
 - ✓ Daily Public Briefing and Social Media Campaigns
- Set up Physical Distancing & Promote Personnel Hygiene
 - ✓ Emergency Decree and Curfew
 - ✓ Promote the motto “Stay home, Stop the Disease, for the Nation”
 - ✓ >50% Work from home
 - ✓ Public space lockdown
 - ✓ Universal wearing Masks , promote physical distancing, washing hands regularly
- Increased Allowance for Vulnerable Groups

- Home delivery of prescription medicine by Village Health Volunteers & Post office
- Medicines pick up at Local Drug Store
- Public & Private laboratory center

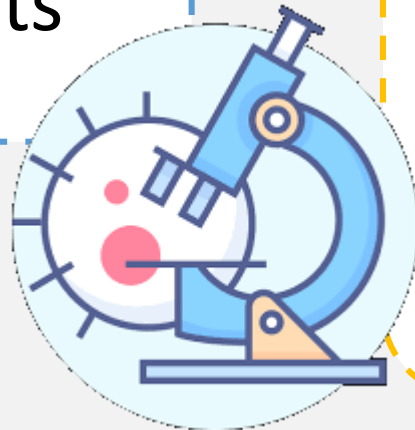




Laboratory Network

(as of July 5th)

79 in BKK and Surrounding
Gov. = 35 units
Private sector = 44 units



205 Laboratory network has passed proficiency testing, the expanding services cover all region with quality monitor system

126 in Provincial
Gov. = 102 units
Private sector = 24 units



Clinical Management and payment on Severity

Categorize confirmed cases into 4 groups and isolate them in hospital. The payment will be covered by Thai UHC

1. Confirmed case without symptoms (asymptomatic infection)
2. Confirmed case with mild symptoms and no risk factors
3. Confirmed case with mild symptom and risk factors:
4. Confirmed case with pneumonia, or in case of normal chest radiograph but presence of symptoms or signs consistent with pneumonia, and SpO₂ at room air <95%

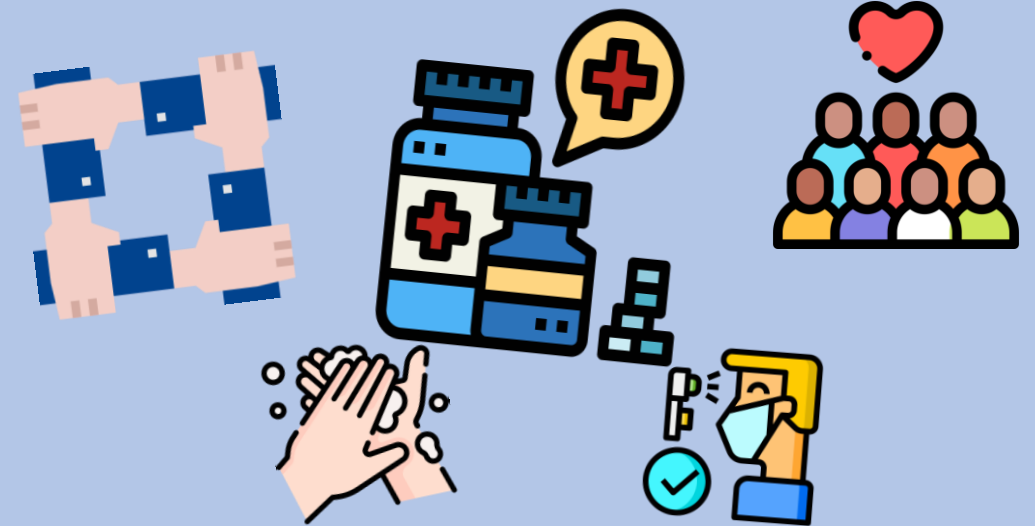
